Brazoria County has been allocated \$1,066,823 for CDBG-CV funds and \$526,152 for ESG-CV funds to prevent, prepare, and respond to the COVID-19 pandemic.

CDBG-CV funds will be used for, but not limited to:

COVID Testing, Homeless Services, Rent, Utilities, Case Management,
Food/Essentials, Counseling and Equipment/Supplies

ESG-CV funds will be used for, but not limited to:

Rent, Utilities and Case Management

These funds will be distributed to various Public Service Agencies throughout Brazoria County to assist residents with their needs during this crisis. CDBG-CV and ESG-CV funded agencies may include, but is not limited, to the following:

Community Health Network, United Way, Salvation Army, ActionS, Brazosport Cares, Alvin Food Pantry, Dream Center, Communities in Schools, Brazos Place, Counseling Connections, Youth and Family Counseling

Brazoria County plans to re-allocate the PY 2019 HOME CHDO Set-Aside funds in the amount of \$71,735.55 to tenant based rental assistance to be used for rent and utility assistance for eligible residents who were affected by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Brazoria County plans to amend the regular PY 2019 CDBG scope of work for the Gathering Place to include homebound meals during a disaster declaration.
